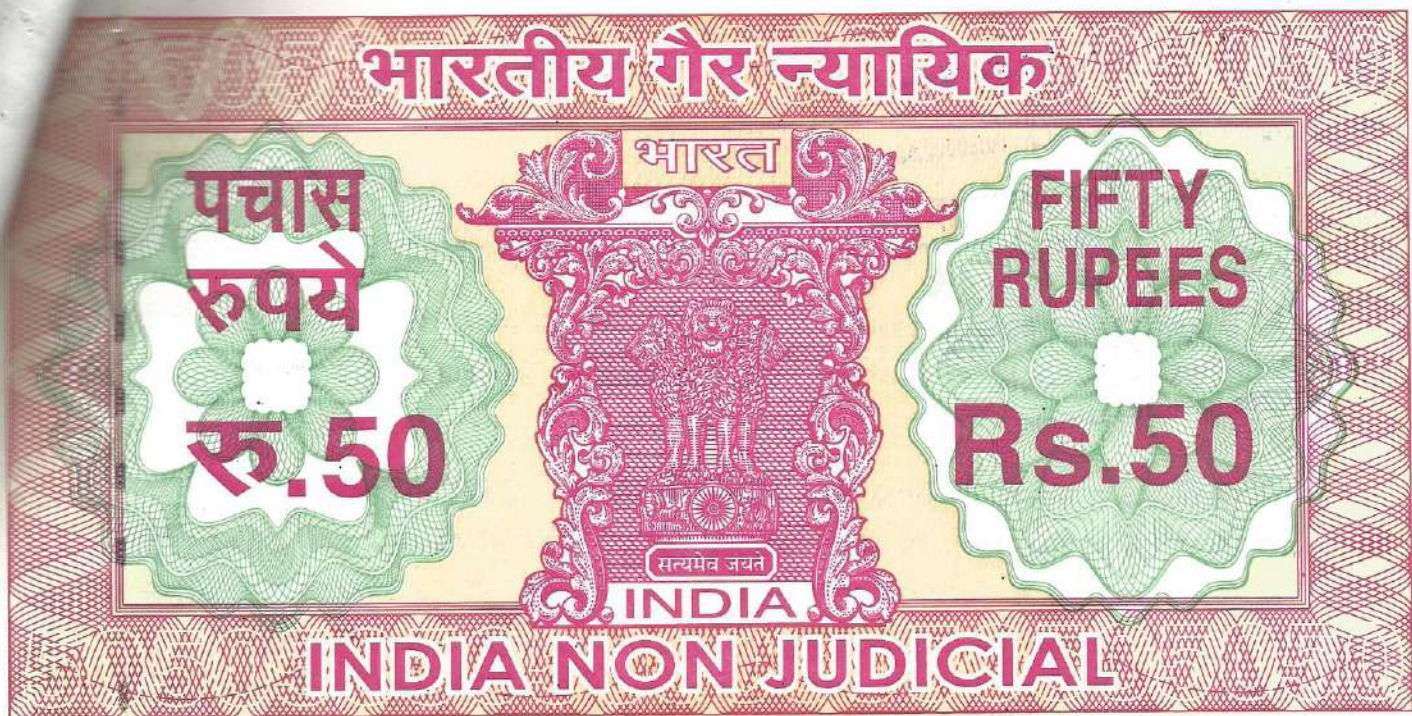

AND WHEREAS with a view to and for the purpose of constitution the Trust permanently for the purpose of carrying on the objectives of the Trust as mentioned hereafter under the "Aims and Objects" clause of this Deed of Trust, it is considered declaration of the Trust should be made in the manner set out hereunder.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

Name of the Trust: **UDAN**

The Registered Head Office of the Trust for the time being shall be at Village & Post: Shyamsundar, P.S. : Raina, Dist.: Burdwan , West Bengal, India, with the power given to the Trustees to shift the same to any other place as they may mutually agreed upon. The office of the Trust may be opened at any other place in West Bengal or is any other state of India or open local office or offices at Places deemed necessary.

4. INTERPRETATION:-

a) Trust means the Trust created by this.

PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST:-

b) The Board shall mean the Board of the members, which may be filled up by co-option of the existing Trustees created by this Deed with renowned and suitable persons.

c) **TRUST PROPERTY:** - shall include every kind of property moveable and immoveable to be owned by the Trust and mentioned in accounts, books and other documents in the possession, custody and control or that ought to be in possession, custody and control or possession of the Trust. The amount Transferred by the SETTLOR as mentioned above, towards the Corpus Fund of the Trust. Any cash, kind, properties, movable, immovable that may be acquired by purchase or otherwise or all manner of rights, title or interest in or over any property movable or immovable. All additions and accretions to the Trust properties and the income there from. All donations, gifts, legacies or grants in cash or kind accepted by the Trustees upon the Trust. The properties of the trust shall be utilized for the objects set forth hereinabove and subject to provisions and conditions herein mentioned.

5. AIMS AND OBJECTS OF TRUST:-

A) Main Objects:

- i. To organize and undertake social welfare program and activities to foster social unity and to reform the society through moral and ethical movements of the self in relation to the society and to organize the dedicated youth to serve the suffering of humanity.
- ii. To establish, maintain and grant aid to institutions for the relief of the poor, minority and advancement of education for the aforesaid purpose or purposes and to grant periodical and other occasional help to the deserving persons.
- iii. To do, any other act for the advancement or general public utility without distinction or discrimination of sex, color, caste, creed or religion.

iv. To grant relief on the occasion of famine, earthquake, other epidemic and other occasion of calamities of similar nature and to give donations, subscriptions or contributions to the institutions, establishments or persons during relief work on such occasions.

v. To start, support, organize and give financial aid to the social, cultural and moral renaissance of the people and to develop physical, mental and educational capacity of the society and to promote schemes for such purposes.

vi. To promote, establish, start, maintain, organize, run, manage, supervise, superintendent, co-ordinance, affiliate, control, guide and grant aid to the schools, college, B.Ed. College, D.Ed. College, pharmaceutical college, B.B.A, M.B.A, B.Tech, B.Tech, separately boys and girls Student with residential institutions for the promotion of the arts, literature, science, commerce and other fields.

vii. To establish, maintain, control, manage and/or render financial assistance medical college, including all treatment facilities to hospitals, diagnostic centers, health centers, nursing home, dispensaries, maternity homes, clinics, sanatorium and other establishments for providing promote medical research in these centers in all faculties and systems of medical practices and provide Ambulance services, arrangement of Medical Van and Medical Unit to the public irrespective of any caste, color and need and to promote research for medicines for cancer and other curable and incurable diseases.

viii. To undertake traditional and experimental activity for the welfare of the orphan children, women, handicapped, blind persons, underprivileged and destitute in the social structure.

ix. To establish, maintain, control, manage and give financial aid to orphanages, widow-homes launch, asylum home for destitute and insane persons and other establishments for relief.

x. To organize, hold and/or arrange to hold seminar, function, workshops, conference, lectures, debates, recitations, symposiums and other cultural and literary eminence and scholars of outstanding national and international reputation for the same for the attainment of the objects the TRUST.

xi. To grant scholarships, stipends, awards and prizes, financial aid and assistances and other emoluments to students, research scholars and to undertake any research works for the attainment of the objects the TRUST.

xii. To distribute educational notes, free book to the poor and / or Intelligent Students.

xiii. To create scope for employment by promoting small-scale, cottage and village industries in the villages and rural areas:

xiv. To organize self help group formation and seminar for the upliftment for the rural economy.

xv. To co-operate with the Government and Non-Government organization for any development activity of the rural and urban areas.

xvi. To raise resource and funds from any sources as consistent with the principals and objects, in conformity with the principals and objects, and in conformity with the interest of the said TRUST.

xvii. To co-operate and connect with national, international organizations, having similar objectives and reputes or receive representatives from such organizations.

xviii. To purchase, take, loan, exchange, rent or hire moveable and/or immoveable property for fulfillment of the purpose of the TRUST.

xix. To take loan from any Government Department, foreign Countries, Non-Government Organization, society's NGO missions and missionaries and the people of all caste and castes and all banks to propagate the TRUST'S aims and objects for economic upliftment of the community.

xx. To work for development of social welfare, health (on the controlling of HIV/AIDS, Malaria and Drugs awareness and sanitary System) and education for the children of rural and urban area.

xxi. To work for development of community awareness and vocational education for the rural Men & Women.

xxiii. To organize seminars, workshop on forum for consumer protection, environmental program, plantation/national integration etc.

xxiii. To perform work on progress of knowledge for rural people and to establish and maintain libraries, reading rooms, adult literacy classes, for educational technical, agricultural or medical knowledge:

xxiv. To organize or make TV Programme on education, Career, Helth, Debate, Social Problems:

xxv. To promote social, civic, moral activities to take care for orphans or of aged helpless man/woman:

7. To act in such a way that the TRUST hereby established shall always retain the status of one such TRUST to which provisions of section 80G/12A/35AC (1 & 2)/FCRA 10(23C) IV/V/VIA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any modification replacement ore thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation or contribution there to be recognized as eligible for exemption or relief from tax in the hands of the donor.

8. ADMINISTRATION: - The properties and funds shall vest in the name of Trustees constituted by persons executing the Deed of the Trust. The number of members of Board of Trustees shall not exceed 11 (eleven) and the vacancies can be filled by cooption by the existing Trustees.

9. The first board of Trustees shall be consisted of:

III. VACANCIES:-

A vacancy shall arise among the Trustees in the following cases

- i. When a Trustee dies.
- ii. When he resigns his office as a Trustee.
- iii. If he/she becomes Bankrupt.
- iv. If he/she becomes in same or otherwise, become incapable to actor.
- v. When he is absent from three consecutive meeting of the board, unless the board records condoning such absence in the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Trustees for substantial cause.
- vi. When it becomes insolvent.
- vii. When convicted of any criminal offence involving moral Turpitude.
- viii. When he acts or does anything detrimental to the interest of the Trust.
- ix. On medical evidence when he is declared physically or mentally unfit by a resolution of the Board at a meeting convened for the purpose.

11. FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:-

PRESIDENT:-

- i. President WILL BE ELECTED BY THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS trustees present in the meeting convened for the purpose.
- ii. The President is empowered to take decisions on any matter, but such be approved by the Board within a period of 30 days.
- iii. The President will preside over the meeting of the Trust and conduct the proceedings and President can to take any decision when other members of TRUSTESS will be absence in the Trust meeting.
- iv. The President in his own decision or by the request of the third of existing members can call for the meeting of the Trustees.
- v. The President is empowered to delegate such powers to any other member of the trust as he may deem fit.

vi. The President is empowered to dissolve the committee or the Board in any abnormal situation.

SECRETARY:-

The Secretary who will act as Managing Trustee of the Board of Trust, elected under the control and supervision of the Board, shall conduct and manage all the affairs of the Trust, its all properties and institutions, sign papers and carry on the despondence on behalf of the Trust, and shall be responsible for the safe custody of records of the Trust, and keeping of the proper accounts thereof. He/She shall also perform such other duties as may be entrusted to him/her from time to time by the Board provided. In the absence of the Secretary the President, authorized on the behalf may sign papers, carry on correspondence on behalf of the Trust, and do all or any of the duties relating to the Secretary under this Organization.

TREASURER:-

The Treasurer shall conduct and receive all of subscriptions, donations and deposit or money and grant receipts of money thereof. He will maintain and keep cashbook and such other books of accounts as are necessary.

12. NO PERSON BEING:-

- i. An undercharged insolvent; or
- ii. Convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude; or
- iii. Of unsound mind; or
- iv. A minor;
- v. Shall be eligible to be a Trustee.

13. The Board of Trustees may, by a unanimous vote of all the Trustees for the time being except the Trustees proposed to be removed, remove any Trustee, permanent or otherwise, from office after finding the Trustees proposed to be removed guilty of serious misconduct in relation to or covering the Trust estate or Trust estate or Trust affairs and after arriving at definite conclusion that for the reasons to be recorded in within the continuance of the Trustees proposed to

... he removed as Trustees or these presents was desirable keeping to the object of the Trust in view other related or connected matters provided however that on conclusion of such shall be arrived at without giving to the Trustee proposed to be removed a full and fair opportunity of explaining his conduct and/or the charges leveled against him for his removal and the decision of the decision of the Board of Trustees in this behalf shall final and shall not be called in question anywhere.

14. APPOINTMENT OF THEIR EMPLOYEES:-

They shall have also power employ necessary staff for management, administration and running of the Trust in general and of institution in particular on such reasonable salaries and remunerations and on such terms as may be appear proper, to the Trustees for managing the affairs of the Trust and the Institutions and for the purpose of achieving of the objects of the Trust. They may be allotted or entrusted with such duties and responsibilities.

15. The President and the Secretary and the Treasurer shall jointly operate Bank Accounts on behalf of the Trust. Any two among them are authorized on their behalf. In their absence, the Board of Trustees may authorize any of the Trustees by a resolution, to operate the bank accounts. One or more Bank Accounts may be opened in any Bank and or Banks in the name of the Trust.

16. THAT the TRUSTEES may engage themselves and carry on any business for and on behalf of the TRUST established by this Deed and may invest any part of funds or assets of the TRUST fund in such business or Businesses for the benefit of the beneficiaries and in such case individually that TRUSTEE shall remain responsible for his/her wrong and loss and for this the TRUST MANAGING TRUSTEE and the SETTLOR shall remain indemnified.

17. THAT the TRUSTEES shall maintain the true and fair account of the TRUST FUNDS, receipts and disposed of or spent and all matters in course of management of this TRUST, in respect thereof or in relation to the carrying out the object and effects to the TRUST PROPERTY. The accounting year of the TRUST shall be accounted for i.e. from 1st April to 31st March, of each English calendar year:

18. THAT the number of TRUSTEES shall be not less than Two (2) and not more than Eleven (11). THAT the TRUSTEES shall have the full power to compromise or to compound all actions against such suits and settle all accounts relating to the TRUST PROPERTY and to do all suits and settle all accounts relating as fully and effectually as if they were absolutely entitled to the TRUST PROPERTY without being liable or answerable for any loss thereby.

20. THAT the receipt of the TRUST for any money, stock, funds, shares, securities or investments paid delivered or transferred to them in execution of the TRUST or power here of shall effectually be released and discharged the persons paying delivering or transferring the same.

21. THAT the TRUSTEES jointly shall be responsible for such money, stocks, shares, funds and securities as they actually receive notwithstanding their respectively signing a receipt jointly with other for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable and accountable for the account, receipts neglects and any banker, broker or other person or persons with whom or whose hands any TRUST moneys or securities may come or be deposited or given or for insufficiency of any stocks, shares, funds or other securities nor for any other loss unless the same shall happen through their default or negligence respectively:

22. THAT the TRUSTEES shall reimburse and pay and discharge out of the TRUST FUND all expenses incurred in course of the execution and administration of the TRUSTEES and in use or for carrying out their duties these presents but they shall not be entitled to any honorarium or salary for the TRUST:

27. THAT the power to appoint/nominate new or additional TRUSTEES so as not to exceed the maximum number of TRUSTEES existing herein and to fill vacancy in the office of the TRUSTEE shall vest in the continuing TRUSTEES or TRUSTEES.

2. The board shall also determine from time to time, the amount it shall spend on the various activities of the Trust.

32. AMENDMENTS:

1. While this Trust shall be irrevocable, the Board of Trustees may amend any of the clauses except those relating to objects of the Trust, the First Managing Trustee and First Trustees, at a duly convened meeting of the Board with at least 2-week's notice, and by a resolution passed by at least three-fourths majority of the Board of Trustees present and voting. The amendments to the Trust deed can only be passed by a resolution of the Board of Trustees in an actual meeting and not by circulation.

2. If any alteration or amendment is necessary, the same shall be affected through supplementary deed/deeds with the previous approval of the commissioner of Income Tax and these shall be read together with the main trust deed.

33. INDEMNITY:

The Board of Trustees shall be indemnified for any act done by them in good faith in the course of the administration of the Trust.

34. APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT.

The provisions of the Indian Trust Act. 1882 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents.

35. APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX ACT:

All clauses herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax on the income of contributions and donations to the Trust and any clause or portion of this Deed of Trust which is inconsistent with or repugnant to the sections of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be deleted or modified with affect from the date on which the sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent clause into force.

36. DISSOLUTION:

In the event of dissolution of the Trust, the entire Trust funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust. The assets left if any, shall be disbursed to other Trusts or Associations having similar objectives after obtaining previous approval of commissioner of Income tax and in no event, it shall be distributed in any manner, to any of the Board of Trustees or their relatives or related or related concerns.

DECLARATION:-

I. This Trust and Scheme set forth under Indenture shall come into force immediately after the execution and registration thereof. The Settlor and Trustees above named also hereby declare that they have consented to be the Trustee under this Trust and that in witnesses thereof the Settlor, Trustees above named as party hereto have affixed their signature hereunder.
